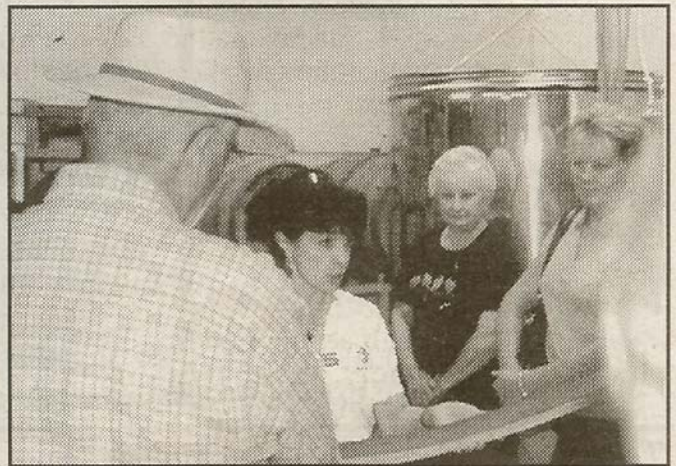
### Juneteenth Celebration
